In the next couple of months there will be very important meetings regarding the issue of the council, etal. I would like to encourage as many of you as possible to make

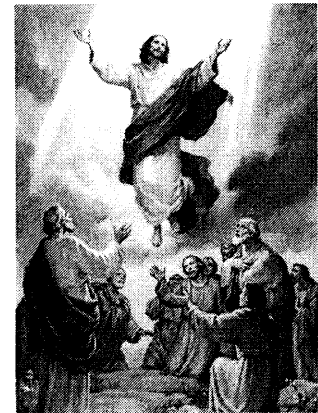
these meetings. Your input is very important to us and we would like to hear from you.

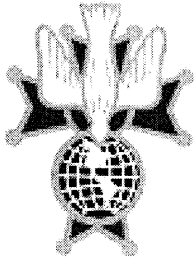

## Fr Carroll Council Building

A meeting of the board of officers took place on Thursday, April 22nd at 7:00pm to address the real problem of the lack of new funding. The Council, Affiliates and the "New" Catholic War Veterans have tried to come up with ways to produce new monies so that we could maintain a council building. Over the past year and a half we tried by having a monthly activity and the most recent, a 100 Club (see attached flyer) so that we could create monies to pay the bills and then ultimately have cash for charities. It seems that the problem is the failure of members to participate and support these activities. As reported by PGK Joe Gavin, he has sold only 39 tickets out of 100 over the course of the Fund Raiser. We have close to 300 members, where are the other 261. It is embarrassing that we can't even sell 100 tickets. Every year we get 1000 C&B Books from the state to sell. Most of us just buy the books and send in the money. When I said most of us, I am referring to most of the usual supporting members.

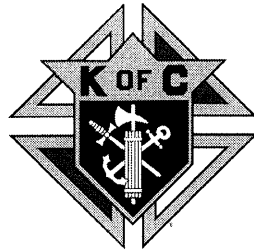
