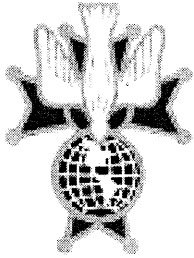

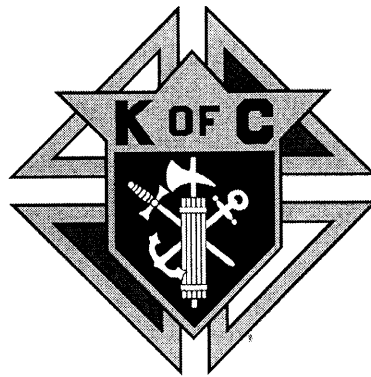

### Membership Qualifications

A person who is both an American Citizen and a Veteran of the Armed Forces of the United States of America (including those on active duty) as herein defined is eligible for membership in the Catholic War Veterans of the United States of America, Inc.

An applicant shall be a member of the Catholic Church as defined in section 2 of the Constitution; enlisted, drafted, inducted or commissioned into any branch of the U.S. Armed Forces, including its Reserve and National Guard components. Anyone who served at least 90 days in the U.S. Merchant Marines between December 7, 1941 and December 31, 1946 is also eligible.
